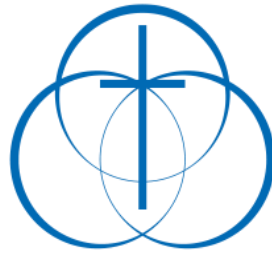

“We Are Blessed”

(Summarized sermon from January 4, 2026)

God is the God of blessing. Blessing is not based on our performance or circumstances, but on who God is and who we were created to be.

The first time the word “bless” appears in Scripture is in Genesis 1, where God blesses living beings and humanity with fruitfulness, multiplication, and authority. From the beginning, life itself was given as a blessing. To be human—to bear God’s image—is already a divine gift.

The Hebrew word barak means to bless by declaring life. When God blesses, He releases life, fruitfulness, and protection. God never withdrew His blessing from humanity because it was never based on human effort, but on His unchanging nature.

The same word barak is used when we bless the Lord in worship and when God’s people bless one another. Through blessing, grace flows from God to His people, and praise rises from His people to God. In this way, blessing becomes a shared life within God’s covenant.

God blesses His people, and His people, in turn, become channels of that blessing to others.

Genesis 12:1-3 (NKJV)

Now the Lord had said to Abram:

“Get out of your country,

From your family

And from your father’s house,

To a land that I will show you.

² I will make you a great nation;

I will bless you

And make your name great;

And you shall be a blessing.

³ I will bless those who bless you,

And I will curse him who curses you;

And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

Message of Salvation

Are you saved?

Are you confident that you would go to heaven if you died at this moment?

Here is the good news for you.

Everyone dies because of sin, and after that ...

You will die someday because of sin. You cannot avoid death, and death is not the end, but the beginning of an eternal life. What's important is where and how you will live eternally. With eternal happiness in heaven or eternal suffering in hell? If you deal with your sin, you can enter heaven and live there eternally. How?

Jesus Christ has redeemed your sin.

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came to this world and bore the cross shedding his blood to redeem your sin and triumphed in his resurrection. Through his sacrifice, Christ paid off your sin and purchased a place for you in heaven, which he offers as a free gift.

If you want for your sins to be forgiven and to be saved ...

1. Accept Christ's invitation by repenting your sins by asking,
"Lord, I repent of all my sins. Please forgive all of my iniquities I have committed and lead me to your kingdom."
2. Confess, "Jesus Christ is my Savior," by praying,
"Lord, I confess that You are my Savior who can deliver me from the eternal damnation of sin and death. Come into my heart and be my master for my entire life."
3. Rejoice, you are forgiven and given an eternal life without condemnation.
4. Congratulations! You become a child of God and a citizen of Heaven.

What's next?

1. Read the Bible, the Word of God, in which you will find Truth and Peace.
2. Join a local church where you will grow in faith.
3. Do good works as much as you can. Sharing God's love for others is a form of worship.
