

Sermon Notes for February 1, 2026

Matthew 5:13-16 (NKJV)

“You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men.

¹⁴“You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all *who are* in the house. ¹⁶Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Last Week's Sermon Summary (January 25, 2026)

"Trust God with your Dreams"

Psalm 37:4–5(NIV)

"Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this."

Today's message reminds us that **God is the giver of dreams and the one who fulfills them**. As we shared our ministry visions last week, we were reminded that the church's vision includes **each person's vision**, because the church is made of people. No matter our age or season of life, dreaming is a gift God has given to us.

Many of us can look back and see dreams that have already been fulfilled—sometimes in unexpected ways. Others may still be waiting. The encouragement today is this: **do not give up on the dreams God has placed in your heart**. When we place our dreams into God's hands, He works through them in His time and His way.

Psalm 37 shows us a simple but powerful path for how God fulfills dreams:

1. **Take delight in the Lord**

God desires a relationship with us, like a loving Father with His child. When we rejoice in Him and enjoy His presence, our hearts become aligned with His will.

2. **Commit your way to the Lord**

We can make plans, but God directs our steps. To commit our way to Him means to rely on His wisdom, trusting that He knows what is best for our lives.

3. **Trust in the Lord**

Trust is the heart of faith. Like a child jumping into a father's arms, we step forward not because we have all the answers, but because we know who is holding us.

Joseph's life reminds us that dreams may take time and may pass through hardship, but **God is faithful**. Joseph did not lose his faith, his attitude, or his integrity—and God fulfilled the dream He had given him.

Conclusion

God is still the One who gives dreams, and He is still the One who fulfills them.

Your age does not limit your dream.

Your past does not cancel your future.

Your weakness does not stop God's power.

So church, **dream again, trust again, and walk forward with God**, knowing that His promise remains true: "Trust in Him, and He will do it."

May the Lord guide your dreams, strengthen your faith, and lead you step by step according to His perfect will.

Message of Salvation

Are you saved?

Are you confident that you would go to heaven if you died at this moment?

Here is the good news for you.

Everyone dies because of sin, and after that ...

You will die someday because of sin. You cannot avoid death, and death is not the end, but the beginning of an eternal life. What's important is where and how you will live eternally. With eternal happiness in heaven or eternal suffering in hell? If you deal with your sin, you can enter heaven and live there eternally. How?

Jesus Christ has redeemed your sin.

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came to this world and bore the cross shedding his blood to redeem your sin and triumphed in his resurrection. Through his sacrifice, Christ paid off your sin and purchased a place for you in heaven, which he offers as a free gift.

If you want for your sins to be forgiven and to be saved ...

1. Accept Christ's invitation by repenting your sins by asking,
“Lord, I repent of all my sins. Please forgive all of my iniquities I have committed and lead me to your kingdom.”
2. Confess, “Jesus Christ is my Savior,” by praying,
“Lord, I confess that You are my Savior who can deliver me from the eternal damnation of sin and death. Come into my heart and be my master for my entire life.”
3. Rejoice, you are forgiven and given an eternal life without condemnation.
4. Congratulations! You become a child of God and a citizen of Heaven.

What's next?

1. Read the Bible, the Word of God, in which you will find Truth and Peace.
2. Join a local church where you will grow in faith.
3. Do good works as much as you can. Sharing God's love for others is a form of worship.
