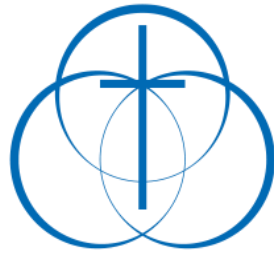

## Sermon Notes for April 19, 2026

### Scripture: Psalm 23 (NKJV)

The Lord *is* my shepherd;

I shall not <sup>[a]</sup>want.

<sup>2</sup> He makes me to lie down in <sup>[b]</sup>green pastures;

He leads me beside the <sup>[c]</sup>still waters.

<sup>3</sup> He restores my soul;

### Sermon Summary (April 12, 2026) Rev. Gloria Jun “The Grace of Restoration”

In John 20:19–29, the risen Jesus appears to His disciples who are filled with fear and uncertainty. He speaks peace, restores their faith, and commissions them for mission.

This message reminds us that restoration is God's grace. Through Christ, our peace, faith, and purpose can be renewed. Even when we struggle with doubt like Thomas, Jesus meets us with compassion and leads us to deeper belief.

Ultimately, God's restoration extends beyond our present lives to the promise of a new heaven and new earth, where all things will be made new.

#### Key Truth:

Jesus restores our peace, renews our faith, and calls us into His mission.

#### Call to Action:

Receive His peace, stand firm in faith, and live out His mission with confidence.

## Message of Salvation

*Are you saved?*

*Are you confident that you would go to heaven if you died at this moment?*

*Here is the good news for you.*

### **Everyone dies because of sin, and after that ...**

You will die someday because of sin. You cannot avoid death, and death is not the end, but the beginning of an eternal life. What's important is where and how you will live eternally. With eternal happiness in heaven or eternal suffering in hell? If you deal with your sin, you can enter heaven and live there eternally. How?

### **Jesus Christ has redeemed your sin.**

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came to this world and bore the cross shedding his blood to redeem your sin and triumphed in his resurrection. Through his sacrifice, Christ paid off your sin and purchased a place for you in heaven, which he offers as a free gift.

### **If you want for your sins to be forgiven and to be saved ...**

1. Accept Christ's invitation by repenting your sins by asking,  
"Lord, I repent of all my sins. Please forgive all of my iniquities I have committed and lead me to your kingdom."
2. Confess, "Jesus Christ is my Savior," by praying,  
"Lord, I confess that You are my Savior who can deliver me from the eternal damnation of sin and death. Come into my heart and be my master for my entire life."
3. Rejoice, you are forgiven and given an eternal life without condemnation.
4. Congratulations! You become a child of God and a citizen of Heaven.

### **What's next?**

1. Read the Bible, the Word of God, in which you will find Truth and Peace.
2. Join a local church where you will grow in faith.
3. Do good works as much as you can. Sharing God's love for others is a form of worship.
